About the InnoServe Awards

Entering its 28th year, the International ICT Innovative Services Awards (InnoServe Awards) is an annual ICT application competition held for university and college students. The objective of the InnoServe Awards is to provide a platform for students to present their information management projects as part of their graduation requirements; while at the same time, promoting academic-industry collaboration by integrating academic training and practical experience.

To date, more than ten thousand teachers and students from over one hundred universities and colleges have participated in the Contest which has become the largest and the most significant contest of its kind in Taiwan.


> The Challenge

The InnoServe Awards 2023 challenges teams to design and build prototypes of "innovative ICT applications." Qualified teams are required to perform a live demonstration of their prototypes in English (including 6 minutes Presentation and 7 minutes Q&A session) at the Final Round in Taipei, Taiwan.

Eligibility

- The contest is open to all students currently enrolled in undergraduate or graduate programs at accredited colleges or universities worldwide.
- Each team may consist of up to 8 eligible students and must have at least one, but no more than two mentors.
- If the team have won another ICT-related contest award(s) in the past, please provide the proof for reference.
- Products already commercialized are not allowed to enter the contest.

Required Documents & Registration



Step 1: Please register online: InnoServe 2023 Registration

Step 2: Email the word document (Description of Information System) and scanned copy of students' ID card before 27, September.

- A. <u>Description of Information System form</u>: The Description must be submitted in MS Word Format (.doc or .docx). It must be in English and limited to 3 pages. Maximum file size is 1.5MB.
- B. Scanned Copy of all participated Students ID Card (front and back)
- C. <u>Project Preview Video (3 mins)</u>: The Video must be uploaded to YouTube with private settings (change the privacy settings for that video to Unlisted) and entered into the registration form with a link to the video.

Judging Criteria

Entries will be judged by a panel of judges consisting of representatives from the industry, government and education sectors.

- Innovativeness 30%
- Practicability 45%
- Presentation Performance 15%
- Document Integrity 10%

Prizes

- 1st Prize: NTD \$120,000 (Approx. USD \$4,000) per team
- 2nd Prize: NTD \$50,000 (Approx. USD \$1,750) per team
- 3rd Prize: NTD \$30,000 (Approx. USD \$1,000) per team
- Best Innovation Award: Certificate
